

Regulations of the competition for the best poster and the best science report presented during the Session of Young Scientists as part of the 2nd Scientific Conference "Interdisciplinary View on Health Sciences" in memory of professor Piotr Lass

23 - 25 NOVEMBER 2022

1. Target audience

The competition is addressed to Young Scientists, i.e. PhD students, students and science clubs taking active part in the sessions of the 2nd Scientific Conference "Interdisciplinary View on Health Sciences" in memory of professor Piotr Lass, hereinafter referred to as the Conference.

2. Objectives of the competition

- disseminating research results consistent with the interest of young scientists as members of research teams, in the field of interdisciplinary aspects of health sciences;
- inspiring scientific activity and scientific discussions;
- shaping the skills of scientific speeches in academic forums.

3. Place and time of the competition

The competition will be held at the place of the Conference.

4. Subjects of the competition

The subjects of the competition are:

- a scientific report presented during the Conference delivered by a PhD student or student who is the only author or the first co-author or representative of the Student Scientific Society/student club;
- a science poster, the only author or the first co-author of which is the Young Scientist, presented during the Poster Session.

5. Settlement of the competition and prizes

- Reports and posters will be assessed by the Competition Committee appointed by the Organizing Committee of the Conference on a point scale, in a secret ballot.
- The authors of the oral report and poster with the highest score will be awarded.
- The results of both competitions will be announced during the Conference during its ceremonial closing.
- Laureates will receive diplomas and material prizes.

6. Formal requirements

- Oral reports presented during the Young Scientists Conference Session should be prepared in Microsoft Power Point or Open Office Impress, and the duration should not exceed 15 minutes.
- Posters should contain the title, information about the authors (affiliations), in particular about the Young Scientist. Maximum poster dimensions: A1, i.e. width 60 cm x height 84 cm.
- Place of displaying the posters: boards indicated by the Conference Organizers and ONLINE in connection with the hybrid conference mode.

7. Final provisions

The organizers reserve the right to develop and publish the results of the competition. By entering the competition, you consent to the processing of personal data to the extent necessary for this.
